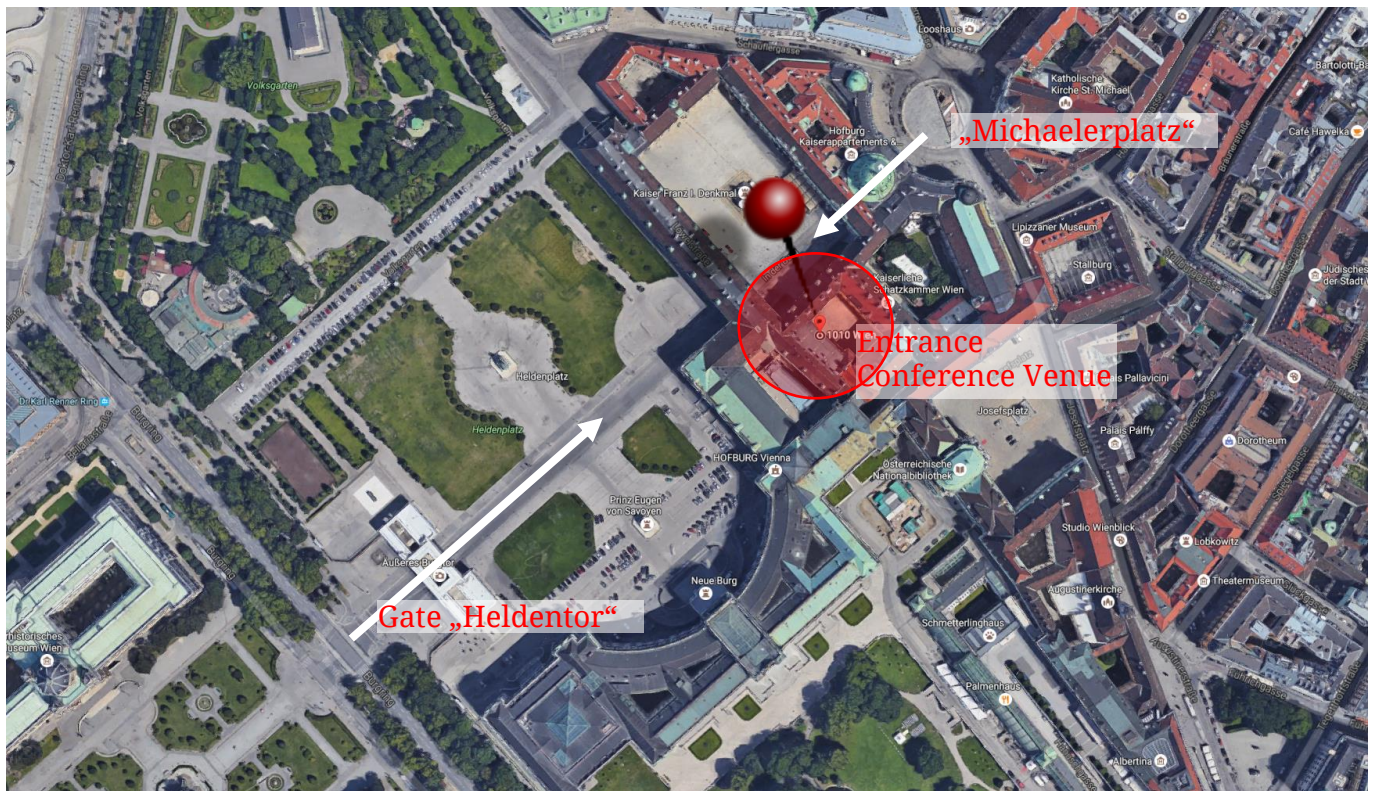
Address of the Event Venue:

Hofburg Imperial Palace Vienna / Congress Center Hofburg
Entrance Botschafterstiege – Schweizerhof
1010 Vienna

The Imperial Palace Hofburg Vienna –Venue of European Cybersecurity Talks - is a huge complex. Part of the palace forms the official residence and workplace of the President of Austria. The Event will take place in the Hofburg Congress Center (marked in red in the image below).

The entrance of the European Cybersecurity Talks Venue is located in the second courtyard of Hofburg Palace, called “Schweizerhof” and can be reached either from the gate “Heldentor” or from the square “Michaelerplatz”.

Contemporaneously to the European Cybersecurity Talks the ACM CCS 2016 takes place in the Imperial Palace Hofburg Vienna. The “Zeremoniensaal” is located on the first floor, just follow the signs.

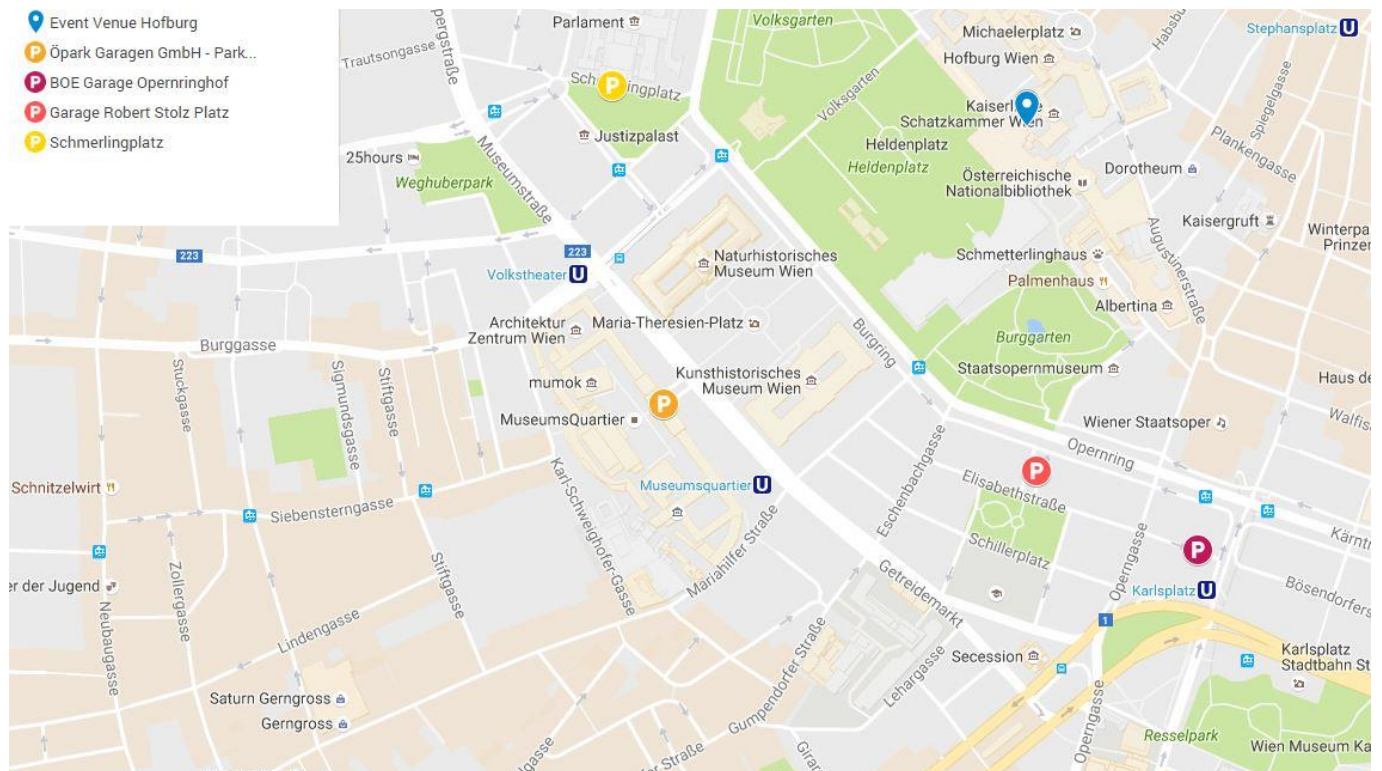
How to get to the Event Venue by car

It is not permitted to park at the Heldenplatz on working days.

How to get to the Event Venue by public transport

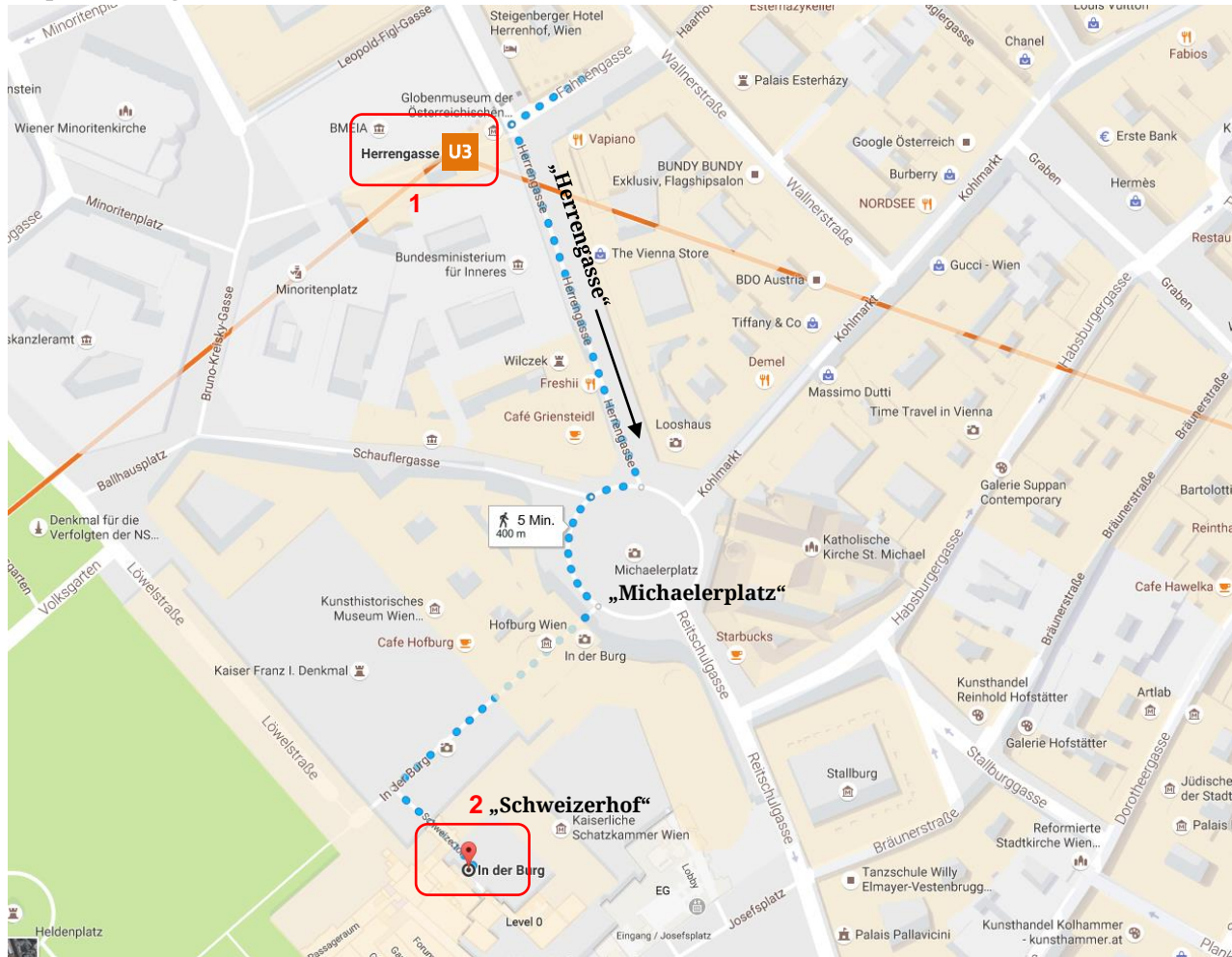
The closest underground stops are “Herrengasse” (U3), “Stephansplatz” (U1/U3) and “Volkstheater” (U2) (see map on first page).

Walking Distances from metro stops

Using the orange underground line – U3

Get out at the orange underground line U3, stop “Herrengasse” (1), using the exit “Fahnengasse”. From there it is just a 6 minutes’ walk to the venue. Follow the street “Herrengasse” until you reach the square “Michaelerplatz”.

Stop “Herrengasse” to the Event Venue:



Map 1: Herrengasse (U3) to Event Venue – (1) U3 stop Herrengasse (exit: Fahnengasse), (2) Event Venue

Using the red underground line – U1

Get out at the red underground line U1, stop “Stephansplatz” (1), using the exit “Graben”. From there it is just a 10 minutes’ walk to the venue. Follow the “Graben” until you can see the shop “Julius Meinl” on the corner, take the street “Kohlmarkt” to your left and follow this street until you reach the square “Michaelerplatz”.



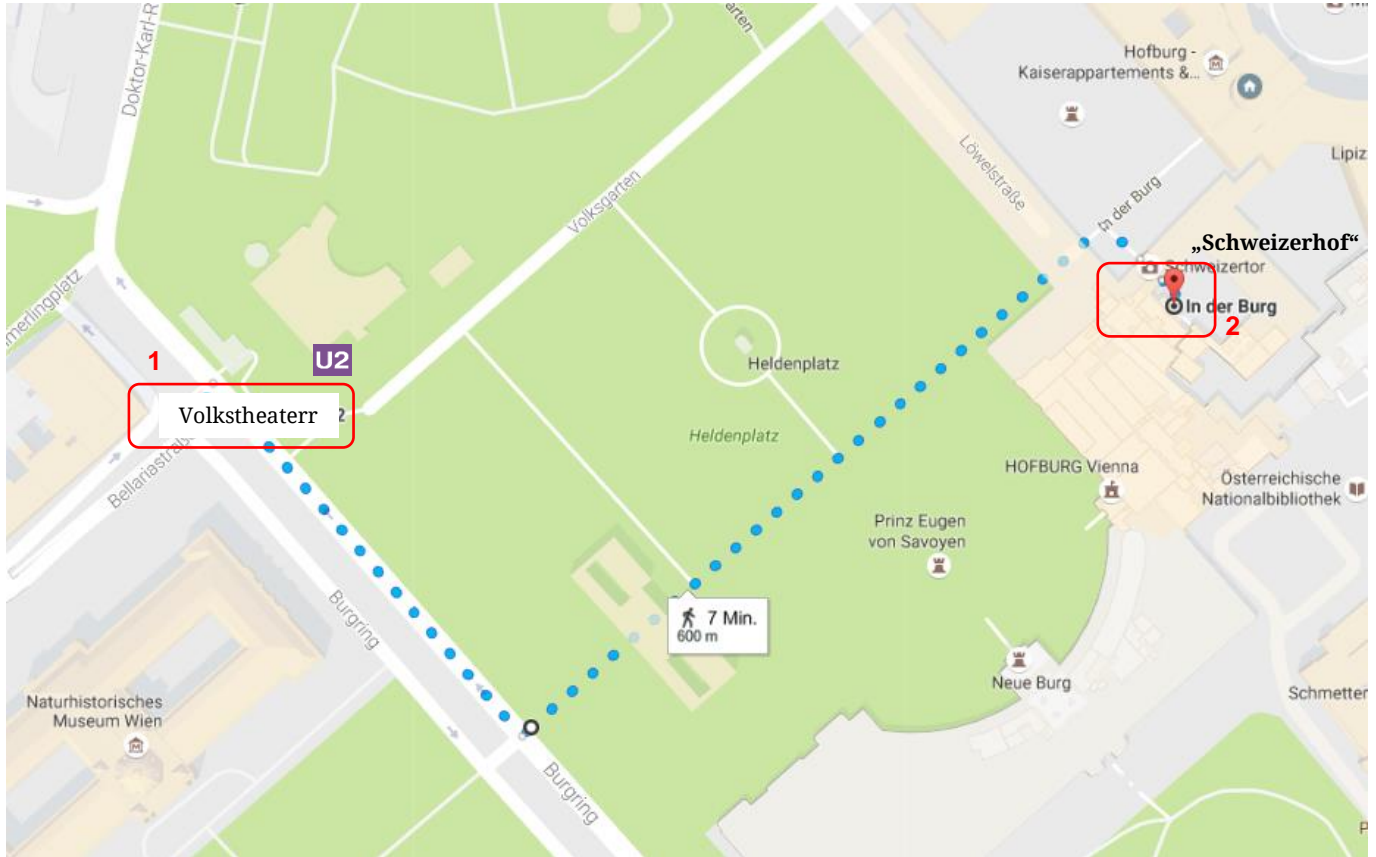
Map 2: Stephansplatz (U1/U3) to Event Venue – (1) U1/U3 stop Stephansplatz (exit: Graben), (2) Event Venue

Michaelerplatz – Event Venue

At “Michaelerplatz” you will find the entrance to the Imperial Palace Hofburg Vienna – walk through the passage – the entrance to European Cybersecurity Event Venue can be found in the next courtyard, called “Schweizerhof”

Using the purple or orange underground line – U2 / U3

Get out at the purple underground line U2 / orange underground line U3, stop “Volkstheater” (1), using the exit “Dr. Karl Renner Ring”. From there it is just a 7 minutes’ walk to the Event Venue. Follow the “Burgring” (the big boulevard) until you can reach the gate “Heldentor” on your left-hand side, and enter the square “Heldenplatz” by going through the gate. Follow the street until you get into the second courtyard “Schweizerhof”.



Map 3: Volkstheater (U2/U3) to Event Venue – (1) U2/U3 stop Volkstheater (exit: Dr. Karl Renner Ring), (2) Event Venue

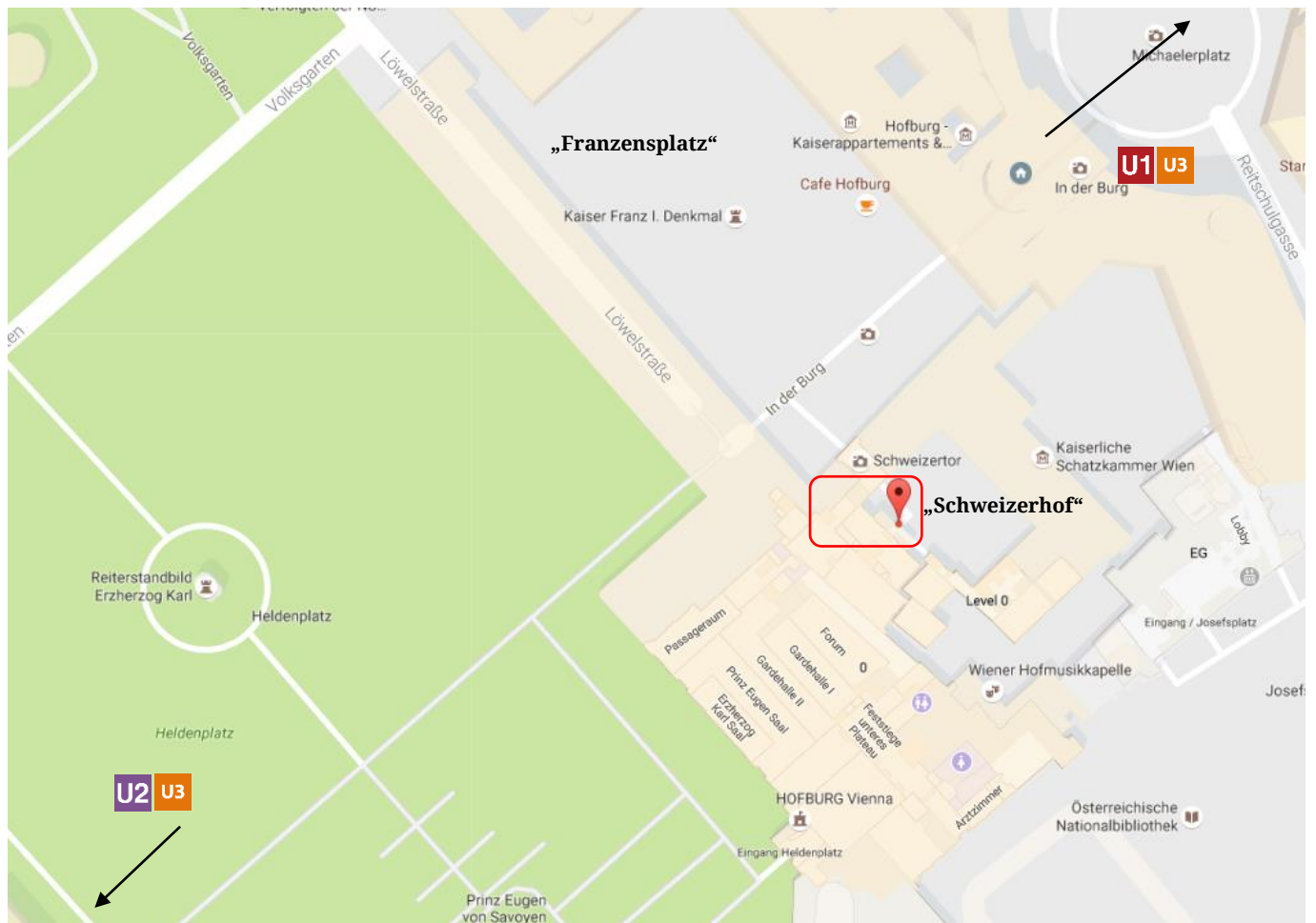
If you are coming from the “Burgring” (boulevard) you are entering the “Heldenplatz” (the big square in front of the Vienna Imperial Palace Hofburg) through the gate “Heldentor” (1), passing by the square “Heldenplatz”.

Entrance “Schweizerhof”

From the big courtyard “Franzensplatz“ you have to pass the gate “Schweizertor” (2) and you are standing in front of the European Cybersecurity Event Venue.
